This year your child's report will look vastly different from last year. As previously announced we have moved to a progression based report for you child. This year it is a far more interactive experience with more things to click and read. Please read the following information to get the best out of your child's report.

Once you login to your child's report you will see their page with  at the top of the page, if you have multiple children please click the  at the top of the page, this will enable you to see all of your children's faces and their individual reports.

On your child's home page you will see the following items






Badges - These are awarded to students once they complete a level or a stage. They are awarded by the teacher, different icons mean different subjects.



Subject Areas - These will have green numbers beside them, this means a comment, picture or information has been added to this subject area. You will have previous years comments here as well. Click on the subject area to read information.



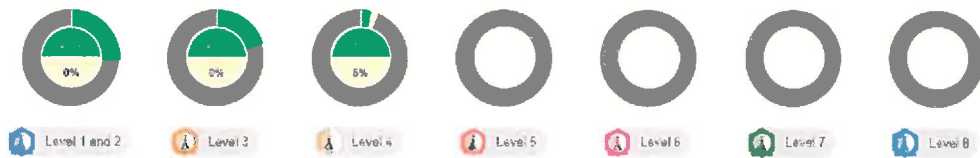
Progression Circles - This shows you the level your child is currently working in.

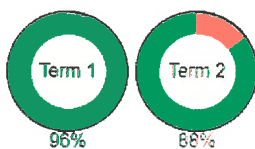
Student Voice
